

The Global Shrimp Forum 2022

<u>Update: May 2, 2022—Early-Bird Registration Extended</u>



On March 17, 2022, the <u>Aquaculture Stewardship Council</u> (ASC), <u>Contango AS</u>, and <u>Shrimp Insights</u> announced the establishment of the Global Shrimp Forum 2022 (GSF)—a conference for executives in the "warm water shrimp industry". The first conference will take place on September 6-8, 2022, in Utrecht, The Netherlands, and will include more than <u>20 sponsors and partners</u>. GFS anticipates attendance of 400-500 industry executives.

Willem van der Pijl, the owner of Shrimp Insights and a Board Member and Managing Director at GSF, says, "I am a strong believer in dialogue, and I am convinced that the timing is right to have a conversation within the shrimp industry about how to secure a long-term resilient and sustainable sector that benefits the millions of people around the world that depend on it for their livelihoods."
